A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAVARES, FLORIDA, RESPONDING TO THE CITY OF EUSTIS'S RESOLUTION 16-27 REGARDING THE NEGOTIATION OF AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO PART II OF CHAPTER 171 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES; ACCEPTING THE CITY OF EUSTIS'S INVITATION TO NEGOTIATE AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT; SUBJECT TO THE RULES, REGULATIONS AND OBLIGATIONS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAVARES COUNCIL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Eustis adopted Resolution 16-27 on March 17, 2016 (the "Initiating Resolution"), inviting , Lake County and the Cities of Mount Dora, Leesburg, Tavares and Umatilla to begin negotiations towards the entering of an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement as authorized by Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 171,203, Florida Statues, provides for interested municipalities to participate in the negotiation of an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement through the adoption of a responding resolution; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the statute is to encourage "intergovernmental coordination in planning, service delivery, and boundary adjustments"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tavares desires to negotiate with the participating governing bodies concerning the unincorporated area of real property and service delivery for that unincorporated area;



Section 1. The City of Tavares, Florida hereby accepts the invitation to participate in the negotiation of an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement between Lake County and the Cites of Eustis, Mount Dora, Leesburg, and Umatilla that was initiated by the City of Eustis through Resolution 16-27.


