

**ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE
CITY COMMISSION MEETING
March 16, 2006**

MINUTES

The Commission voted unanimously to **approve** the minutes of the February 28, 2006 – City Commission Meeting/Retreat and March 2, 2006 – Regular City Commission Meeting.

CONSIDERATIONS

1. The Commission voted unanimously to **submit** an application for Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters' Grant.
2. The Commission voted unanimously to **approve** the amendment to the current contract with PRMG, Inc., for water and wastewater rate update to include an update of water and wastewater impact fees.
3. The Commission voted 5-0 to **schedule** a workshop on March 24, 2006 beginning at 3:00 p.m. and March 25, 2006 beginning at 9:00 a.m. to review the Five-Year Budget Forecast 2006-2010. Both workshops to be held in the Library Community Room.
4. The Commission voted unanimously to **accept** the 9/30/2005 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.
5. The Commission voted unanimously to **approve** the reimbursement of costs related to the 2006 Washington Birthday Festival to various accounts from the General Fund.
6. The Commission voted unanimously to **approve** the agreement for legal services.
7. The Commission voted unanimously to **award** City RFP #004-06 – Cash Management/Banking Services to SunTrust Bank.
8. The consensus of the Commission was for the Las Fuentes Project to **annex**.
9. The Commission voted 5-0 to **schedule** a Fair Housing Meeting for April 6, 2006 at 7:15 p.m.
10. The Commission voted 3-2 (Commissioners Rotella and Smith dissenting) for **approval** of the plat, acceptance of the HOA document, and letter of credit for infrastructure improvements associated with the Spring Ridge Estates subdivision with the condition that any substandard lot be brought up to minimum size.
11. The Commission voted 3-2 (Commissioners Rotella and Smith dissenting) to **accept** the Cambridge Home Proposal for the Royal Property and requested that the City contact Tavares regarding the Commission's disappointment on how the annexation was handled and to begin negotiations on a JPA.
12. The Commission voted unanimously to **donate** two (2) City owned lots to Habitat for Humanity of Lake County.

OTHER

1. Vice Mayor Manning requested that letters be mailed to Barbara Martin of Barbara's Restaurant for providing the food and Aletia Brown for getting the door prizes for the Golden Seniors Program.
