



### **Wastewater Department on the “rise”**

Construction of a second floor to the Wastewater Department’s administration offices will soon turn from plans to reality very soon. The actual construction of the second floor is anticipated to start within the next two to three weeks. The Wastewater Department, with the assistance of the Water Department, Public Works, and the Public Utilities surveyors, are prepping the Office bldg grounds for the cement footers for the new second floor addition to the office/ control building. When completed, it will consolidate under one roof various department functions which are currently spread out over several locations, including Environmental Compliance Inspections, Lift Stations, operations and supervisory offices.
