Each year, the Festival attracts artists from all over the country. A panel of jurors hand-selects the finest artists with the highest quality of works. The artists chosen will be competing for \$10,000 in prizes and representing a multitude of styles including painting, mixed media, photography, graphics, sculpture, glassworks and so much more.

In addition to a feast for the eyes, visitors will enjoy a variety of live entertainment by local music favorites. The Festival is pleased to announce headliners such as singer/songwriter **Larry Mangum** who has released four albums and has logged nearly 3,000 performances over the last four decades as a folk, rock, country and Americana artist. Another heavy-hitter is **Bob Rafkin**, the premier singer, songwriter, producer and guitar finger-stylist, who has played on sessions for greats such as The Everly Brothers and Arlo Guthrie, and has released seven separate albums. You don't want to miss our full lineup of talented musical acts to include local resident and three-time Florida State Fiddle Champion, **Jonathan Hodge**; **Work Release Program** - Central Florida's premier folk festival trio; the contemporary stylings of local favorite **Doug Spears**; and **Tom La Venia & Larry Ziegenfuss**, the powerful guitar-violin duo that is commanding audience attention and excitement in Central Florida.
