Eustis Police arrest Key Avenue trio

EUSTIS – The Eustis Police Department SWAT Team executed a search warrant on April 9th at 30 East Key Avenue, removing narcotics from the residence with a street value in excess of \$2,000.00. Three individuals living at the residence were arrested; all have lengthy criminal histories involving drugs, weapons, and are all convicted felons.

Robert James Donaldson, 32, has been charged with possession of marijuana with intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a church, possession of cocaine with intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a church, possession of Xanax with intent to distribute within 1000 feet of a church, and possession of paraphernalia, bond \$50,000.00

Anthony Young, 17, has been charged with possession of marijuana less than 20 grams, possession of paraphernalia, and possession of ammunition by a convicted felon. He has been remanded to the custody of his parents.

Willie B. Lowe, 53, has been charged with possession of ammunition by a convicted felon, bond \$10,000.00

The arrests of the aforementioned subjects are the culmination of a two month drug investigation, by the Eustis Police Department Narcotics Unit, that started as an anonymous complaint. Even though the subjects moved to avoid detection, police were still able to maintain the integrity of our investigation and end the investigation with arrests.

The men and women of the Eustis Police Department are committed to the continued effort to remove drugs, and those using and dealing drugs out of the community.
