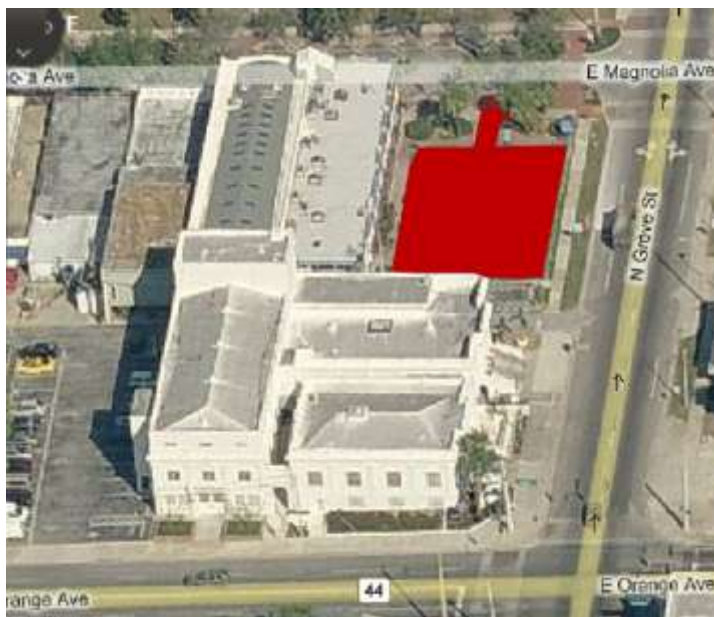

## City to provide more parking for Downtown Businesses New public parking area precedes the Downtown Streetscape Project beginning in April 2010

**Eustis, FL** - Construction will begin in April on the Downtown Streetscape Project. In order to ensure sufficient parking for downtown businesses, as well as City employees, the parking lot north of City Hall will become a public parking lot and the parking lots south of the parking garage and behind the Finance Annex, will become the designated reserved parking areas for all employees who work in the City Hall Building at 10 N. Grove Street and the City Finance Annex at 10 S. Eustis Street.

The driveway entrance from Magnolia Street will be constructed the weekend of March 13 - 14, 2010 and will re-open on Monday, March 15, 2010. As of that date, the “reserved parking” signs will be gone and parking will be on a “first come first serve”

basis only. The lot north of City Hall will be open to the public on that date; however, employees may continue parking there through April 16, 2010. On Monday, April 19, 2010, all employees must park in one of the designated reserved employee parking lots.

As a reminder, a design review community open house regarding the Magnolia and Eustis Streetscape / Infrastructure Project will be held from 6 – 8 pm, Tuesday, March 16<sup>th</sup> at Eustis City Hall, 10 N. Grove Street. The purpose of the open house is to let the public review the construction documents that were prepared as a result of the series of community planning meetings.
