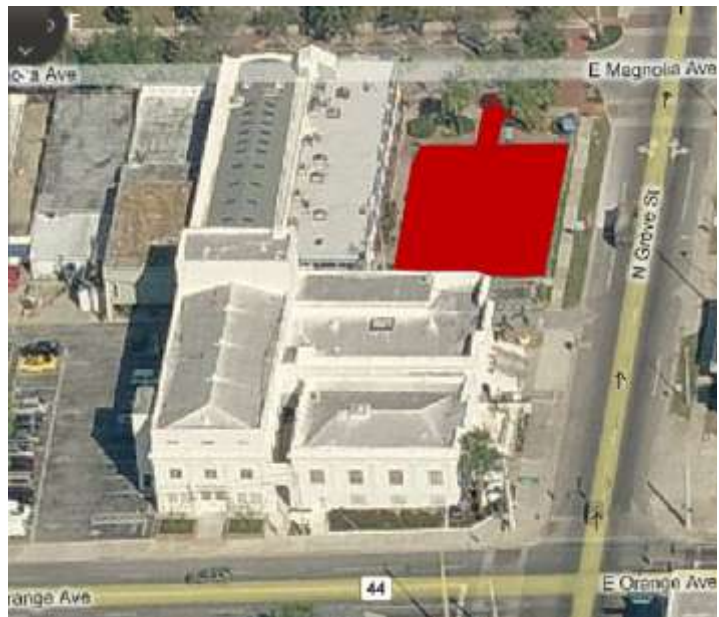

New Public Parking Project delayed one week Project rescheduled due to recent heavy rain

Eustis, FL - The construction of an entrance opening of the new public parking area north of City Hall has been delayed 1 week due to recent heavy rain. The driveway entrance from Magnolia Street is now scheduled for construction on the weekend of March 20 – 21, and will re-open on Monday, March 22, 2010. As of that date, the “reserved parking” signs will be gone and parking will be on a “first come first serve” basis only. The lot north of City Hall will be open to the public on that date; however, employees will continue parking there through April 16, 2010. On Monday, April 19, 2010, all employees will park in one of the designated reserved employee parking lots.
