Featured Sculpture Artist: Marsha DeBroske – “Basking in the Moonlight” & “The Pack”

Eustis, FL – Marsha DeBroske was born in Yonkers, New York, and acquired her MA in art education from Syracuse University. She taught art for twenty-five years emphasizing art history and cultural diversity. In 1999 she moved to Orlando to actively pursue her art career and has become well-known for her sculptures and paintings.

“My art tries to capture the gesture and essence of the being I am creating,” said DeBroske. “The sculptures are psychological and deal with universal feelings such as loneliness, detachment, fear, power, and joy. I create a raw and primitive feeling to evoke emotion while viewing the sculpture. The art can be viewed at different levels of meaning and depends on the viewer’s perspective.”

In described the process she used to create “Basking in the Moonlight”, DeBroske states, “I work in wax creating one of a kind sculpture. Each piece is then cast in bronze using the lost wax process. Bronze is a raw and a primitive material used for thousands of years. Human beings are still dealing with emotions such as power, greed, love, hate and will continue to explore these emotions throughout the ages. Therefore, the material and the art are well suited for each other.”

Although “The Pack” may look like bronze, it is not. “I modeled Apoxie Sculpt, a self-hardening synthetic clay, around two armatures creating the howling wolves,” said DeBroske. “I tried to capture that moment in time when wolves are trying to find one another – that desperate howl.”
