

Welcome to the City of Eustis quarterly newsletter! Our City offices will be closed for the following observances (Federal Holidays); November 11 for Veterans Day, November 24 & 25 for Thanksgiving, and December 23 & 26 for Christmas.



City Projects:

Bates Ave WWTP Expansion: The Phase 1 engineering package has been completed. Phase 2 Engineering has been awarded, and the team is now in design to provide the construction plans. The engineer and Construction Manager provided a cost estimate that was submitted to City staff and are currently reviewing alternatives.

Eastern WWTP Transfer Pump Station: This project will coincide with the reclaim pond lining project. Construction site crews have finished the installation process on the pump station and have started testing the new equipment. The contractor is scheduled to do a final walkthrough.

Woodward Avenue: The contractor's crews finished installing the sewer pipe between Donnelly St. and Schultz St., manholes at several intersections along Woodward Ave., and the stormwater piping and structures along Woodward Ave. The crews are currently working the final phase by rebuilding the curbing and roadways. The project is estimated to be completed by end November 2022.

Umatilla Wastewater Interconnection with the City of Eustis: The City of Umatilla's contractor completed the installation of the wastewater pipe and fittings in order to make the connection to our Wastewater Treatment Plant. The crews installed new piping and resurfaced the roads and curbs on Pinkney St., Hollywood Ave., and Bates Ave. Currently, the crew is continuing to work on the electrical and mechanical components.

Coolidge Street Improvements: Utility improvements will take place along Coolidge Street. Engineering design included field investigations, water / wastewater modeling, and a developed plan for construction procurement assistance. City staff and engineering are recollecting all the data and are performing field investigations before starting any construction.

City of Eustis Commission Qualifiers for 2023

The qualifying period for the City of Eustis Commission Seats #1 and #2 closed on August 12, 2022. Michael Holland is unopposed for Seat #2 and will be sworn in at the first meeting in January 2023.

Gary Ashcraft and Bruce Johnson both qualified for Seat #1 and will be on the November 8 ballot. The winner of that seat will also be sworn in at the first meeting in January 2023.
