

Residential Driveway Information

- 1. A permit is required to construct or remove a driveway. The permit must be posted onsite.
- 2. Permit submittal requirements: Two copies of plans showing the following:
 - All existing and proposed building/parking layouts; and a north arrow and date on the plans.
 - Existing and proposed driveway location(s) and width(s).
 - Location and width of existing street(s).
 - Retaining walls, drainage structures, utility poles and other features that may affect driveway locations.
- 3. Driveway construction requirements include the following:
 - Minimum driveway widths: Single Drive 12 feet Double Drive 18 feet
 - Driveways shall not be closer than five feet from property corners, and must be a minimum of three feet from stormwater inlet structures.
 - Concrete or asphalt drives may not be closer than three feet from side property lines.
 - From the property line to the edge of road pavement (City right-of-way), driveways must be paved with six inch thick concrete reinforced with 10-10x 6"x6" mesh or 1" asphalt with 6" compacted limerock base.
 - On roads with curb and gutter, vally gutters shall be required in driveways and shall be placed in line with the gutter line.
 - New pavement shall conform to the existing paved street grade.
