Ferran Park Seawall Rehabilitation

The City Staff has been actively monitoring the seawall for several years, tracking the crack widening while securing funding for necessary repairs in the City's Capital Improvement Plan.

The City hired Dredging Marine Consultants to design a cost-effective bulkhead wall repair which involves the following:

- Driving 8-inch diameter steel pin piles to design tip elevations on the waterward side of the bulkhead wall.
- Filling the pin piles with concrete and encasing them in additional concrete up to approximately one foot below the mudline.
- Replacing the existing steel cap to ensure structural integrity and longevity.

This project ensures the long-term stability and safety of the Ferran Park seawall, addressing existing structural concerns and enhancing the park's resilience for future use.
