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What is the IrisPRO Pave and why is it in our community?

The ICC IrisPRO Pave is a specialized tool used by trained field crews to assess and evaluate the condition of roads in your community. It helps us identify areas that may need maintenance or rehabilitation to ensure safe roadways for residents.

Why is pavement maintenance important?

How does the IrisPRO Pave work?

The IrisPRO Pave is equipped with cameras and sensors that measure and record the surface conditions of roads. It assesses factors such as cracks, erosion, slope, grade, obstructions, and lack of accessibility features. The data collected helps us prioritize areas that may require attention to maintain or improve pavement quality.

Will the IrisPRO Pave disrupt traffic or my daily routine?

Our crews are committed to minimizing disruptions to residents. The IrisPRO Pave is driven down roads the same way any other vehicle does, utilizing automated data collection techniques, creating virtually no disruption in traffic.

What happens after the IrisPRO Pave assessment?

The data collected by the IrisPRO Pave guides our pavement maintenance and rehabilitation program. Once the assessment is complete, our engineers prioritize areas for maintenance based on the severity of issues identified. This proactive approach helps us address concerns before they become more significant problems.
