UPCOMING PROJECTS

Public Utilities

Bates Avenue Wastewater Treatment Upgrades

Work began in June of 2023. This \$12.2 million dollar upgrade will increase plant capacity from 2.4 MGD to 3.2 MGD. Completion is scheduled for September of 2024.

McDonald Avenue Sewer Upgrade

This project should begin around the end of October though no firm date has been given. It will involve putting in a new sanitary line on McDonald Ave from the west side of Bay St /SR 19 to an existing line just west of McCulloch's Alley. McDonald Avenue will be closed for the duration of the project, which should be roughly 60 days.

Public Works

Lift Station 9 Improvements

The Contractor is in the demolition phase of fencing, concrete surfaces and sewer well lids. In addition, the contractor is going to install a temporary piping assembly that will bypass the wastewater flow in order to work on the sewer wells. The Contractor is also working on installing the drainage piping.

Eustis Water / Wastewater Masterplans

The City now has comprehensive water and wastewater master plans to assist staff in planning for future growth as well as to troubleshoot future infrastructure challenges in a more efficient manner.
